are hereby issued a permit to use waters from APPLEGATE RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, A TRIBUTARY OF APPLEGATE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69060 with a date of priority of APRIL 20, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 22.0 ACRE-FEET of stored water only, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- (1) SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T 38 S, R 5 W, WM; 100 FEET NORTH & 550 FEET EAST FROM CENTER CORNER, SECTION 1.
- (2) S 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, WM; APPLEGATE DAM.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

ACRES 1/41/4 SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM

supplemental 22.00 SW SE 35 37 S 5 W

Total: 22.00 supplemental acres.

The use of water under this permit is subject to the terms and conditions of Contracts 1-07-10-W0297 and 1-07-10-W0298 between the Bureau of Reclamation, the applicants and Clifford E. and Credellia D. Willson or satisfactory replacements, copies of which are on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 18, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan.
