### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from CRYSTAL SPRINGS CREEK, JENNIE'S CREEK, CHARLIE'S CREEK, TRIBUTARIES OF WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK & RESERVOIR 1 & RESERVOIR 2 TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-69111, Permit R-10905 for DOMESTIC USE FOR THREE FAMILIES AND IRRIGATION OF 12.87 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69112 with a date of priority of MAY 27, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FROM CRYSTAL SPRING CREEK FOR DOMESTIC; 0.06 CFS FROM JENNIE'S CREEK & RESERVOIR 1 FOR IRRIGATION OF 3.77 ACRES & 0.11 CFS FROM CHARLIE'S CREEK & RESERVOIR 2 FOR IRRIGATION OF 9.3 ACRES provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year. or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

point 1 SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, T 2 N, R 3 W, WM;  
1050 FEET NORTH & 475 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 19.

point 2 SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, T 2 N, R 3 W, WM;  
875 FEET NORTH & 350 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 19.

point 3 SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, T 2 N, R 3 W, WM;  
595 FEET NORTH & 10 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

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The place of use is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
