is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from A SPRING AND AN UNNAMED STREAM, TRIBUTARIES OF ROSS SLOUGH for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69140 with a date of priority of JUNE 19, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM SPRING, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY TO BE MADE UP FROM AN UNNAMED STREAM FOR IRRIGATION OF SAID LAWN OR GARDEN or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 6, T 26 S, R 12 W, WM;
1080 FEET SOUTH & 1000 EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 6.

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 6, T 26 S, R 12 W, WM;
980 FEET SOUTH & 1040 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 6.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991
