is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF SALT CREEK for STOCK WATERING AND IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69540 with a date of priority of MARCH 2, 1988, FOR STOCK WATERING & MARCH 7, 1988, FOR IRRIGATION. The permit is limited to not more than 0.135 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FOR STOCK WATERING & 0.125 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 5, T 7 S, R 5 W, WM; 255 FEET SOUTH & 420 FEET WEST FROM NW CORNER, ANDREW A. WHITTLEY DLC 39.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
