PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER & TWO UNNAMED RESERVOIRS (POND 2 & POND 3) TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-69437, PERMIT R-10907 for NURSERY OPERATIONS. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69438 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 30, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 1.5 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 1.5 CFS FOR CONTAINERIZED STOCK USE & 15 GPM FOR GREENHOUSE USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. It is further provided that water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

point 1 SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T 1 S, R 3 W, WM;
20 FEET NORTH & 2720 FEET WEST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 30.

point 2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 30, T 1 S, R 3 W, WM;
61 FEET SOUTH & 1030 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 30.

point 3 NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 30, T 1 S, R 3 W, WM;
238 FEET SOUTH & 95 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 30.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan.
