is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from UNNAMED TRIBUTARIES OF LITTLE MALHEUR RIVER AT THE LAVA SPRING, ELWOOD SPRING AND CANTEEN SPRING SITES for LIVESTOCK. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 67472 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 11, 1983. The permit is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM EACH SOURCE, PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.015 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

point (1) NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 32, T 15 S, R 36 E, WM;
500 FEET SOUTH & 1100 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 32.

point (2) SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 34, T 15 S, R 36 E, WM;
2300 FEET SOUTH & 1300 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 34.

point (3) SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 34, T 15 S, R 36 E, WM;
50 FEET NORTH & 500 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 34.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 10, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
