is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from UNNAMED TRIBUTARIES OF SQUAW CREEK AT THE FEATHER SPRING, DAVE SPRING, DOLORES SPRING, SQUAW SPRING, JACKSON SPRING AND HAMMS SPRING SITES for LIVESTOCK. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 67477 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 11, 1983. The permit is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE, PROVIDED THE TOTAL DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES DOES NOT EXCEED 0.015 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- point (1) LOT 7, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 6, T 15 S, R 37 E, WM; 700 FEET NORTH & 500 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 6.

- point (3) NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 8, T 15 S, R 37 E, WM; 2200 FEET NORTH & 2500 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 8.
- point (4) SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 9, T 15 S, R 37 E, WM; 600 FEET NORTH & 50 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 9.
- point (5) SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 13, T 15 S, R 36 E, WM; 600 FEET NORTH & 900 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 13.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
