is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from UNNAMED TRIBUTARIES OF MALHEUR RIVER AT THE SKOOKUM SPRING, REFRIGERATOR 1, REFRIGERATOR 2, HOFFMAN SPRING, WESTFALL SPRING, ROCK SPRING, LOWER ROCK SPRING, HAWK SPRING, BEAR SPRING, JUNIPER SPRING, LOST SPRING, CRIB SPRING, JUMP OFF TRAIL, MCALLISTER SPRING, DUNIEN SPRING and LAKE CAMP SPRING SITES for LIVESTOCK. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 67481 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 11, 1983. The permit is limited to not more than 0.016 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE, PROVIDED THE TOTAL DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES DOES NOT EXCEED 0.016 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.
