is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from UNNAMED TRIBUTARIES OF BLUEBUCKET CREEK AT THE PALMER SPRING, JACKSON SPRING AND BLUEBUCKET SPRING SITES for LIVESTOCK. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 67492 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 11, 1983. The permit is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE, PROVIDED THE TOTAL DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.02 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, T 17 S, R 35 E, WM; 600 FEET NORTH & 1100 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 32.

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 6, T 18 S, R 35 E, WM; 2200 FEET SOUTH & 1300 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 6.

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 5, T 18 S, R 35 E, WM; 1600 FEET SOUTH & 1400 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 5.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

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Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 10, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
