is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from AN UNNAMED SPRING, A TRIBUTARY TUALATIN RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF ONE-HALF ACRE NON-COMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69483 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 24, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

Provided that the right allowed herein shall be further limited during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year to human consumption and livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 25, T 1 S, R 5 W, WM;
1810 FEET NORTH & 50 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 25.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

	1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
DOMESTIC	NE SE	25	1 S	5 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 10, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
