are hereby issued a permit to use the waters from ROGUE RIVER, TRIBUTARY OF PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF A NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69666 with a date of priority of JULY 22, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 35, T 35 S, R 7 W, WM;
1805 FEET NORTH & 2592 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

This development was reviewed and considered by the Water Resources Commission on September 16, 1988.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
