## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from POORMAN CREEK WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM POORMAN CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM AN UNNAMED STREAM, TRIBUTARIES OF GRAVE CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69696 with a date of priority of AUGUST 26, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.01 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, T 33 S, R 7 W, WM; 650 FEET NORTH & 600 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, NW1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 27.
- 2 NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, T 33 S, R 7 W, WM;
  650 FEET NORTH & 290 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, NW1/4 SW1/4 SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

ACRES 1/41/4 SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM

DOMESTIC 0.50 NW SW 27 33 S 7 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 29, 1989, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
