## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

are hereby issued a permit to use the waters from DAIRY CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF TUALATIN RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 35.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69498 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 27, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 0.44 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 27, T 1 N, R 3 W, WM; 1275 FEET SOUTH & 280 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

Provided further that the pump intake be screened to meet Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's fish screening criteria and to be in compliance with ORS 498.248.
