is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from MENDENHALL CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF WEST FORK DAIRY CREEK for MAINTAINING AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-69589, PERMIT R-11009, FOR RECREATION. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69590 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 14, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.1 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4, SW 1/4, Section 4, T 2 N, R. 4 W, WM;  
SOUTH 6 DEGREES 7 MINUTES 28 SECONDS WEST 595.7 FEET FROM  
CW1/6 CORNER, SECTION 4.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

	1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
RECREATION	NW SW	4	2 N	4 W

Provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

Provided further that the pump intake be screened to meet the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife fish screening requirements and to be in compliance with ORS 498.248.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 9, 1990 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
