is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from ABIQUA CREEK, a tributary of PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION for 106 acres. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69457 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 12, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 320 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 22, T 6 S, R 1 W, WM; 480 FEET NORTH & 200 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, NE1/4 SE1/4, SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
