PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from DEER CREEK, A
TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.35 ACRE.
The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under
Application 69629 with a date of priority of JUNE 1, 1988. The permit is
limited to not more than 0.0044 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent
in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 23, T 27 S, R 5 W, WM;
290 FEET NORTH & 2806 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured
under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-
EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each
acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5
acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each
year.

This permit is further limited during the period July 15 through September 30
of each year to the irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed
0.35 acre in area and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may
be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

	ACRES	1/41/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
primary	0.35	SE NW	23	27 S	5 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 31, 1990, and shall
be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water
to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.
