is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from ANTELOPE CREEK, a tributary of GOOSE LAKE, for ROAD WATERING OF ROAD 383. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 59975 with a date of priority of APRIL 11, 1980. The permit is limited to not more than 50,000 GALLONS PER YEAR or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 38 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 670 FEET NORTH & 90 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 33.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before FEBRUARY 17, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
