The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69449 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 3, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 2.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NORTH 66 DEGREES 01 MINUTE WEST 871 FEET FROM CN1/16 CORNER, SECTION 18.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

1/41/4 SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM DOMESTIC NE NW 18 37 S 3 E

This development was reviewed and considered and findings made by the Water Resources Commission on October 28, 1988.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you

about the land-use plan in your area.
