are hereby issued a permit to use the waters from AN UNNAMED SPRING, TRIBUTARY OF ANDREWS CREEK, AND ANDREWS CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF BILLY CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 8.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69459 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 12, 1987, FOR USE OF 0.1 CFS FROM ANDREWS CREEK AND FOR USE OF 0.0005 CFS FROM SPRING AND NOVEMBER 30, 1988, FOR USE OF 0.0025 CFS FROM SPRING. The permit is limited to not more than 0.103 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.003 CFS FROM UNNAMED SPRING FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.1 CFS FROM ANDREWS CREEK FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

point 1 (spring) NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 2, T 23 S, R 6 W, WM; 1110 FEET SOUTH & 660 FEET EAST FROM C1/4 CORNER, SECTION 2.

point 2 (creek) NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 2, T 23 S, R 6 W, WM; 1225 FEET SOUTH & 1415 FEET EAST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
