The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69700 with a date of priority of AUGUST 31, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.013 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 33, T 34 S, R 4 W, WM; 940 FEET SOUTH & 110 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SE1/4 SE1/4, SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
