is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from TUALATIN RIVER, A TRIBUTARY WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.75 ACRE. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69731 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 4, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 13, T 2 S, R 1 W, WM; 52 FEET NORTH & 416.5 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Provided further that water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 14, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
