is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from HOGWALLOW SPRING (09-4708), a tributary of KRUMBO CANAL CREEK, for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 66531 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 21, 1983. The permit is limited to not more than 3.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 35, T 29 S, R 31 E, W.M.;  
200 FEET NORTH AND 1690 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 35.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

	1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
LIVESTOCK	SE SW	35	29 S	31 E

Actual construction work shall begin on or before MARCH 20, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1991.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
