is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from AN UNNAMED SPRING AND WILLIAMS CREEK, TRIBUTARIES OF CALAPOOYA CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 27.0 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69179 with a date of priority of JULY 1, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.34 CFS FROM WILLIAMS CREEK AND 0.01 CFS FROM SPRING or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

Spring SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 26, T 24 S, R 6 W, WM; 1450 FEET SOUTH & 880 FEET EAST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 27. Creek NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 26, T 24 S, R 6 W, WM; 320 FEET SOUTH & 400 FEET EAST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

ACRES 1/41/4 SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM

DOMESTIC/IRR 27.00 NW NW 26 24 S 6 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 5, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
