is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIUTARY OF ROGUE RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69534 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 9, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, T 36 S, R 14 W, WM;
626.6 FEET NORTH & 1160.2 FEET EAST FROM INTERIOR 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 18, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
