PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from POWDER RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 493.1 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 149.1 ACRES OF WHICH 59.5 ACRES ARE COVERED BY PRIMARY RIGHT TO THE USE OF GROUND WATER AND 72.0 ACRES ALLOWED AN ADDITIONAL RATE OF FLOW, BRINGING THE AMOUNT UP TO THE FULL RATE AND DUTY. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69115 with a date of priority of JUNE 1, 1987. The permit is limited to not more than 15.2 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- point (1) NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 28, T 7 S, R 41 E, WM;
BASCHÉ DITCH-1880 FEET NORTH & 400 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 28.
- point (2) SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 34, T 7 S, R 41 E, WM;
POWDER R. DITCH & DAM-1600 FEET SOUTH & 140 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 34.
- point (3) SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 12, T 8 S, R 41 E, WM;
CRANSTON DITCH-2000 FEET SOUTH & 400 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Provided further that although declared herein to be, in part, for supplemental irrigation of lands covered by existing rights to the use of ground water, the right allowed herein may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The proposed project was reviewed and considered by the Water Resources Commission on April 1, 1988.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
