is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from TAGGARTS CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 46.6 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69711 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 9, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.58 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 20, T 33 S, R 2 E, WM;
1020 FEET NORTH & 980 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

The proposed project was reviewed and considered by the Water Resources Commission on October 28, 1988.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.
