PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from JACKSON CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY, INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF A LAWN OR NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69747 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 31, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 18, T 30 S, R 1 W, WM;
3010 FEET SOUTH & 780 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 18.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

It is further provided that the right allowed herein shall be limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to human consumption, livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family, and irrigation of a non-commercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area.

The place of use is as follows:

1/4 1/4 SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM

DOMESTIC NW SW 18 30 S 1 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
