is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from CALAPOOYA CREEK, BACHELOR CREEK, AND OLDHAM CREEK, TRIBUTARIES OF UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 134.3 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69516 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 30, 1987 FOR USE OF 0.86 CFS FROM CALAPOOYA CREEK AND USE OF 0.58 CFS FROM BACHELOR CREEK FOR IRRIGATION; AND DECEMBER 16, 1988 FOR USE OF 0.12 CFS FROM CALAPOOYA CREEK AND USE OF 0.12 CFS FROM BACHELOR CREEK FOR IRRIGATION AND USE OF 0.05 CFS FROM EACH CREEK FOR LIVESTOCK.

The permit is limited to not more than 1.83 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 0.98 CFS FROM CALAPOOYA CREEK FOR IRRIGATION OF 78.7 ACRES, 0.7 CFS FROM BACHELOR CREEK FOR IRRIGATION OF 55.6 ACRES, 0.05 CFS FROM CALAPOOYA CREEK FOR LIVESTOCK, 0.05 CFS FROM BACHELOR CREEK FOR LIVESTOCK, AND 0.05 CFS FROM OLDHAM CREEK FOR LIVESTOCK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

700 FEET SOUTH & 1300 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25.

1060 FEET NORTH & 1130 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25.
Calapooya Cr. NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 36, T 24 S, R 5 W, WM;
800 FEET SOUTH & 1300 FEET WEST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25.
Bachelor Cr. NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, T 24 S, R 5 W, WM;
2100 FEET NORTH & 250 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25.
Oldham Cr. SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, T 24 S, R 5 W, WM;
1150 FEET NORTH & 1880 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
