PERMIT to APPROPRIATE the PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from CANYON CREEK a tributary of WILLOW CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 18.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69552 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 28, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 15, T 15 S, R 42 E, WM;
1014 FEET NORTH & 1007 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The permit shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior permit for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

It is further provided that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation, the right allowed herein may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water aquifer provided the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

supplemental	4.20	SW SW	15	15 S	42 E
supplemental	8.00	SE SW	15	15 S	42 E

Total: 18.00 supplemental acres.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 12, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.
