is hereby assued a permit to use the waters from THOMAS CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, TO BRING THE AMOUNT OF WATER UP TO THE FULL DUTY FOR IRRIGATION OF 26.0 ACRES AND FULL DUTY FOR IRRIGATION OF 37.8 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69819 with a date of priority of JANUARY 30, 1989. The permit is limited to not more than 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion. The use of direct flow from Thomas Creek is not allowed after August 15 of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 23, T 10 S, R 2 W, WM; 450 FEET SOUTH & 240 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, DLC 66.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
