PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from BRADLEY LAKE, A TRIBUTARY OF CHINA CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF LAWN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69917 with a date of priority of MAY 23, 1989, FOR USE OF 0.005 CFS AND JUNE 8, 1989, FOR USE OF 0.005 CFS. The permit is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 13, T 29 S, R 15 W, WM;
850 FEET SOUTH & 810 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The applicant will be required to install an in-line totalizing flow meter calibrated in acre-feet units of measurement under the supervision of the watermaster before water can be diverted.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

	ACRES	1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
irrigation	0.50	NE NW	13	29 S	15 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 14, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
