THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of JACKSON CREEK, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 69.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69630. The date of priority is JUNE 1, 1988. The use is limited to not more than 0.857 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 13, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 24; DIVERSION 1 - 195 FEET NORTH AND 1005 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 13; DIVERSION 2 - 1195 FEET SOUTH AND 1970 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4	10.1 ACRES	NE 1/4 NE 1/4	31.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4	6.8 ACRES	NW 1/4 NE 1/4	19.4 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.			

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 11, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
