to use the waters of COLUMBIA RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 166.5 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69646. The date of priority is JUNE 22, 1988. The use is limited to not more than 2.08 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 11; SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 1 N, R 2 E, W.M.; DIVERSION 1 - 2410 FEET NORTH AND 4710 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 11; DIVERSION 2 - 424 FEET SOUTH AND 337 FEET EAST FROM THE MEANDER CORNER, BETWEEN SECTIONS 13 AND 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 11, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

The permittee shall provide that the pump intakes be screened to meet Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's fish screening criteria in compliance with the law.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
