PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of SNAKE RIVER WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE SUPPLY TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM A WASTE WATER POND, tributaries of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 50.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69697. The date of priority is AUGUST 26, 1988. The use is limited to not more than 1.25 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 28; NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 19 S, R 47 E, W.M.; RIVER - 1330 FEET SOUTH AND 1860 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 28; POND - 470 FEET SOUTH AND 490 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 29.0 ACRES      NE 1/4 NE 1/4 21.0 ACRES  
SECTION 28      SECTION 29  
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 11, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
