is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from BURNT RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF SNAKE RIVER, and stored water in Unity Reservoir constructed under Permit R-176 for IRRIGATION OF 4.4 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69675 with a date of priority of AUGUST 5, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 30, T 12 S, R 44 E, WM;
2250 FEET SOUTH & 880 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Direct flow from the river will not be allowed after July 30 of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Total: 4.40 acres.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.
