### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF YAMHILL RIVER AND NURSERY RESERVOIR TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-69744, PERMIT R-11149, for RELATED NURSERY USE ON 22.7 ACRES AND CONTAINER NURSERY USE ON 33.6 ACRES.

The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69723 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 23, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 9.56 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 3.32 CFS FOR RELATED NURSERY USE AND 6.24 CFS FOR CONTAINERIZED NURSERY USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

Diversion from the river for beneficial uses will be further limited as follows: during the period November 1 to June 30 the rate of diversion would be limited to 0.56 cfs for nursery uses and up to 8.97 cfs for temperature control. From July 1 through July 31, the rate of diversion would be limited to 0.34 cfs for irrigation only. From August 1 through October 31, direct flow would not be allowed; the applicant can use stored water only.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

River NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 4 S, R 4 W, WM;  
70 FEET SOUTH & 650 FEET EAST FROM NORTH ANGLE CORNER, FORD DLC.

Reservoir NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 23, T 4 S, R 4 W, WM;  
2490 FEET SOUTH & 465 FEET EAST FROM NORTH ANGLE CORNER, FORD DLC.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

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If used for field irrigation for nursery stock, such use is not restricted to the defined agricultural irrigation season.

The proposed project was reviewed and approved by the Water Resources Commission on May 26, 1989.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
