is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from LONG TOM RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER, for BUILDING HEATING AND COOLING. The permit to the use of these waters has been issued under Application 69846 with a date of priority of MARCH 6, 1989. The permit is limited to not more than 0.67 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 28, T 14 S, R 5 W, WM;
930.7 FEET NORTH & 4008.2 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 28.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
SW SE	28	14 S	5 W

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
