### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from AN UNNAMED STREAM and CAMAS RESERVOIR, TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-69893, PERMIT R-11153, A TRIBUTARY OF SALT CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 10.4 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69894 with a date of priority of MAY 11, 1989. The permit is limited to not more than 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 31, T 6 S, R 5 W, WM;  
550 FEET SOUTH & 1375 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed herein from direct flow is limited to the period through June 30 of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

The proposed project was reviewed and approved by the Water Resources Commission on August 17, 1989.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

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This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
