PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from AN UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF TUALATIN RIVER AND RESERVOIR, TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-69898, PERMIT R-11154, for NURSERY OPERATIONS USE. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69899 with a date of priority of MAY 12, 1989. The permit is limited to not more than 1.72 CUBIC FEET PER SECCND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 28, T 1 S, R 3 W, WM;
160 FEET NORTH & 1840 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 28.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

	ACRES	1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
NURSERY USES	6.00	NW NW	28	1 S	3 W
NURSERY USES	7.00	SW NW	28	1 S	3 W

The amount of water used for Nursery Operations (OAR 690-11-110 (14)) is limited to a diversion of 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre. For the irrigation of containerized nursery plants, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre feet per acre. For the irrigation of in-ground nursery plants the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre. The use of water for NURSERY OPERATIONS may be at anytime of the year that the use is beneficial. For the irrigation of any other crop, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed herein from direct flow is limited to the period through June 30 of each year.

This proposed use was reviewed and approved by the Water Resources Commission on August 17, 1989.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

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This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
