PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

is hereby issued a permit to use the waters from NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69922 with a date of priority of MAY 30, 1989. The permit is limited to not more than 0.125 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, T 26 S, R 6 W, WM;
2520 FEET SOUTH & 1180 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The place of use is as follows:

Diversion screening shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992. *

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

* "B" extended to October 1, 1992

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The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
