to use the waters from MOLALLA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 7.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69565 with a date of priority of MARCH 25, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 0.0875 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 32, T 3 S, R 1 E, WM;

410 FEET NORTH & 3303 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

ACRES 1/41/4 SECTION TOWNSHIP RANGE, WM

IRRIGATION 7.00 SW NE 32 3 S 1 E

Actual construction work shall begin on or before SEPTEMBER 26, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
