PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, for IRRIGATION OF 1.2 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69764 with a date of priority of NOVEMBER 22, 1988. The permit is limited to not more than 4.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

RIVER (1) SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 21, T 37 S, R 5 W, WM;  
1550 FEET SOUTH & 2200 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 21 (JOSEPHINE COUNTY).

RIVER (2) SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 6, T 38 S, R 4 W, WM;  
950 FEET NORTH & 200 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 6 (JACKSON COUNTY).

RESERVOIR S 1/2 SE 1/4, Section 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water under this permit is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 9-07-10-W0733 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

ACRES	1/4 1/4	SECTION	TOWNSHIP	RANGE, WM
1.20	NW NW	20	37 S	5 W

On September 8, 1989, the Director made affirmative findings that the proposed use of stored water would not impact the flows in the scenic waterway.

"CERTIFICATE NO. 72759"

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Actual construction work shall begin on or before OCTOBER 19, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
