PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of LOST CREEK RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8142, A TRIBUTARY OF ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.7 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION 47.0 ACRES. The permit to the use of these waters is issued under Application 69870 with a date of priority of APRIL 12, 1989. The permit is limited to not more than 150.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 14, T 35 S, R 7 W, WM;
900 FEET NORTH & 3820 FEET WEST FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The permit shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior permit for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use of water under this permit is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 9-07-10-W0772 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

The use of water allowed under this permit shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

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Actual construction work shall begin on or before OCTOBER 23, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
