## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

W. JAY HOFFMAN 113 WEST 4TH STREET THE DALLES, OREGON 97058

**503-296-11**01

to use the waters of A SPRING AREA and MILL CREEK, tributaries of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.8 ACRE and MAINTENANCE OF HOFFMAN RESERVOIR TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-69070, PERMIT R-11187, for RECREATION.

This Permit is issued approving Application 68850. The date of priority is AUGUST 3, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.013 CFS from Mill Creek for irrigation and 0.022 CFS from Spring Area when available with any deficiency to be made up from Mill Creek, for recreation, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 AND SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 22, T 1 N, R 12 E, W.M.; SPRING AREA - 1500 FEET NORTH AND 600 FEET WEST; MILL CREEK - 930 FEET NORTH AND 800 FEET WEST, ALL FROM S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 RECREATION SE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.8 ACRE SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before NOVEMBER 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
