PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER AND NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, a tributary of COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.25 ACRE AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF A LAWN OR GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 0.25 ACRE.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69587. The dates of priority are APRIL 11, 1988 AND AUGUST 21, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FROM NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER FOR IRRIGATION WITH A DATE OF PRIORITY OF AUGUST 21, 1989, AND 0.01 CFS FROM SPRING WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY TO BE MADE UP FROM NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER FOR DOMESTIC USE WITH A DATE OF PRIORITY OF APRIL 11, 1988, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 11, T 29 S, R 12 W, W.M.; RIVER - 1160 FEET NORTH AND 315 FEET EAST; SPRING - 120 FEET NORTH AND 615 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM NW CORNER, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

LOT 3 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4) 0.25 ACRE & DOMESTIC
SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before NOVEMBER 27, 1990, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
