to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of ALSEA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69967. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 13 S, R 11 W, W.M.; 1600 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET WEST, 2100 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 27.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

NW1/4 SE1/4 SECTION 27 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JANUARY 17, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
