PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

JAMES G. GOEBEL 684 SABLE DRIVE ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70128. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 21, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 26 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 690 FEET SOUTH AND 2280 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 16.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 **SECTION 16** TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JANUARY 17, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
