## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of WALKER-VAN OTTEN RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-1405, a tributary of SALT CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 28.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70140. The date of priority is DECEMBER 13, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 28.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 14, T 6 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 3500 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

3.5 ACRES NE 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 **15.0 ACRES** 7.4 ACRES SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.1 ACRES **SECTION 14** 

TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JANUARY 17, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
