PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

GREEN MOUNTAIN LUTHERAN CAMP, INC.

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR CHURCH CAMP.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69582. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.005 cfs for domestic and 0.025 cfs for church camp, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The right allowed herein for domestic use shall be limited during the period July 15 through September 30 each year to human consumption and livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1005 FEET NORTH AND 1225 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 28.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

S 1/2 SW 1/4
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JANUARY 30, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
