THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of COW CREEK AND GALESVILLE RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-9964, tributaries of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for QUASI-MUNICIPAL AND MUNICIPAL USES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69101. The date of priority is MAY 18, 1987. The use is limited to not more than 0.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND 30.0 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY, being 0.1 CFS and 10.0 AF for Clarks Branch and 0.4 CFS and 20.0 AF for City of Glendale, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

GALESVILLE RESERVOIR SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 31 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2920 FEET NORTH AND 2060 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 28.

CLARKS BRANCH SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 29 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1550 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 7.

CITY OF GLENDALE SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 32 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 130 FEET NORTH AND 2340 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 4, T 33 S, R 6 W, W.M.

Water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 15 to September 30 of each year, except for human and livestock consumption.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before FEBRUARY 9, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

The first of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
